## **Cru® Inner City offers something new for the new year**

There is something about a new year that inspires a time of reflection.

Both Leviticus 23 and Numbers 29 teach us about the annual observance of the Feast of Trumpets, known today as Rosh Hashanah. The festival, held at the end of each summer, is a season of reflection and repentance for the Jews. Centuries later, Americans celebrate a similar time of reflection when we flip the calendar to a new year.

With the start of 2025 still fresh in our minds, I would like to take some time and space to discuss another new element for Cru® Inner City — our new mission statement: "Living out the Great Commandment and Great Commission with churches in the inner city."

Why the update?

We desired something easy to remember, that gives greater context for the heart of our ministry, and creates a conversation piece that encourages questions about how we serve the inner city. Questions spark dialogue.

We started with the Great Commandment because it is *the* basis for the entirety of Scripture. There is nothing greater. As the blueprint for everything else, the first commandment boils down to love — the love for God and the love for others.

The second pillar, based on Matthew 28:18-20, is vital because its two-prong focus guides us in putting that love in action through Spiritled preaching and teaching to expand God's Kingdom on earth. As believers, we must never forget we are called to *all* that Jesus commands, including discipleship and serving the vulnerable.

Another emphasis of our new mission statement is the centrality of the church in everything we do. Notice the wording. We work *with* churches. It's a partnership. It communicates our posture, our communion, and our union with them.

Finally, while we recognize and value the corporate nature of the global Church, our emphasis is distinctly narrow, thus the lowercase "c." The underserved and under-resourced churches of the inner city are our heartbeat.

And what a beautiful rhythm it is.




We can't wait to see how God will work through friends like you ... and our dedicated inner-city partner ministries ... this Easter season!



Oscar, 58, was familiar with the reality of being unhoused. He wore the frigidness deep in his bones. Like many in the homeless community, he also wore the stigma of not being seen. So, it stunned

him when a small group of people approached him one wintry Chicago morning and asked him his name.

The group, from All Nations Church of God in Christ, gifted Oscar with a Homeless Care Kit. The kit, provided by Cru<sup>®</sup> Inner City, contained gloves, a scarf, socks, hygiene basics and gospel literature — all rolled up inside a warm blanket.

Right there, on a cold, snow-covered Chicago sidewalk, Oscar prayed the prayer of salvation, publicly giving his life to Jesus. A Homeless Care Kit paved the way.
